Treasurer Report—Emily Naumann presented the budget. Current balance is \$5,501.15 North Star Donut proceeds from back-to-school night was \$253.80, Spirit Wear proceeds with First Place Spirit Wear were \$521.06, Pizza Day proceeds for the first two weeks \$1,008.28 (a big thanks to Kim for those!), Chipotle restaurant night \$208.54 (thanks Diane!). Thanks to all the extra effort, the PTO budget is in a much better place than last year.

PTO News

- Budget Item Changes—Because of extra funds, small changes were made to the budget.
 Prom and Graduation Reception funds were bumped up while the Lunch Pantry was
 removed as it is now being run on the school level. A \$100 line item was added for feminine
 hygiene supplies and \$500 for Field Trip Expenses to provide needed funds for
 disadvantaged students.
- RaiseRight—easy fundraiser; e-gift cards from hundreds of different vendors, all available for online purchase. This fundraiser is now established. Kim will begin promoting it soon.
- **Pizza Day**—Pizza Day has proven to be a huge benefit to the PTO bottom line! Still looking for 2 to 3 volunteers to lead this effort going forward. Mr. Hoemann requested PTO consider moving Pizza Day to Tuesdays due to dietary limitations for certain students on Monday/Wednesday. This was determined to be unfeasible due to the inability to get the needed number of volunteers on a Tuesday. We will reassess this request next year.
- Applebee's Pancake Breakfast CANCELED—this event was unfortunately canceled due to low ticket sales. Everyone who ordered tickets was refunded.
- **Trivia Thursdays**—Previously held on Tuesdays. A fun lunchtime activity in coordination with lunchroom monitors. Working well in Building A. Check status of other buildings.
