- **Sledding Event 2-4-23**—the kids enjoyed sledding and hot chocolate at Battle Creek Park
- **Pi Day**—Pi Day on 3/14 was a huge success. Lots of great feedback and there were plenty of pies to go around. Everybody loved getting a slice of pie!
- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Open House—Open house went really well last Tuesday. Kim and Diane manned a table stocked with candy at the event.

## **Upcoming Events**

- Healthy Snack Day—previously scheduled event was canceled. Rescheduled to 4/14.
- **Prom 4-29-23** \$1000 is budgeted for this event. Randy will contact the parent in charge of Prom to have them reach out to the PTO.
- April/May Teacher Appreciation—the monthly treat for April 10 is cheesecake! PTO will purchase fresh or frozen cheesecake from Costco for the teachers and staff to enjoy. PTO will coordinate Panera box lunches for May 9. We discussed having parents "sponsor" a lunch for a teacher or staff member like we did last year when funds were low. This is still under consideration as PTO has the funds to cover the lunches. Several box lunch options will be offered, the order submitted, and delivery provided by Panera on the specified date.

- Free Pizza Day 5/31/23—In recognition of the support from pizza-purchasing students all year long, Kim suggested the PTO sponsor a free pizza day on the last Wednesday of May (5/31). Heather K. suggested that first-hour teachers distribute tickets to each student so that we can limit individuals to one or two slices of pizza.

- **Graduation Reception 6/2**—PTO will again sponsor a lemonade and cupcake reception for families of graduating seniors! \$800 is budgeted for the reception.
