- **Volunteer NEED**—PTO is still looking for a PIZZA DAY COORDINATOR, someone who can manage pizza orders on a weekly basis (accounting for school happenings such as fieldtrips, testing, etc.). We are also looking for a RESTAURANT NIGHT COORDINATOR.

Upcoming Events

- Winter All-School Event (1/22)—Molly made lots of phone calls to check into facilities rental in both Woodbury and Cottage Grove on two upcoming non-school days. It was decided PTO will schedule the event on January 1/22 at the *M* Health Fairview Sports Center. PTO will reserve the fieldhouse from noon to 2 pm. An outdoor skating rink is also available for use. Kids can play soccer, bring frisbees, or even board games. Concessions are also available. Skate rental is \$6, but Molly will see if her Sports Center contact will cover the cost of skate rental for an additional flat fee.
